FEBRUARY'S PRESENTATION

In conjunction with Engineers Week at ERAU, Dr. Noor O. Ahmed a computer scientist at the Air Force Research Laboratory in Rome NY, gave a presentation discussing traditional defensive security solutions employ techniques to safeguard systems from sophisticated cyber-attacks. He discussed the problems of cyber security and outlined a design of a Moving Target Defense Framework for Distributed Systems to help thwart cyber-attacks. The talk was extremely timely considering recent reports of break-ins to financial as well as government data systems.

OUR SPEAKER

Dr. Al Helfrick is Professor Emeritus at Embry Riddle Aeronautical University. He started his career in radiation hardening of military systems, then after a stint in the military (including a tour of duty in Vietnam), continued in the fields of cable television, test and measurement, avionics and finally as an independent consultant. Dr. Helfrick joined ERAU in 1991 and retired in 2015 after serving as both a professor and department chair. He is still active in academia, continues to publish and present papers at conferences, and occasionally regale audiences with reminiscences from his career.
