Awards

Our section will offer two kinds of awards in 2019:

1. ENCS Outstanding Engineer Award

The purpose is to recognize the outstanding contribution of local engineers to the engineering profession.

The following are the criteria used by the award committee:

- Outstanding technical contributions to the engineering profession.
- Outstanding professional and leadership contributions to the engineering profession.
- Significant contributions to the local community representing the engineering profession.
- Outstanding contributions in the area of engineering education.

2. ENCS Outstanding Volunteer Award

The purpose is to recognize a volunteer's contribution to the Eastern North Carolina Section.

- Members who played significant roles during a conference where ENCS was involved
- Organizers or significant contributors to ENCS affinity groups (Young Professionals, WIE, Consultants,)
- Members who contributed significantly to ENCS events or operations
- Chapter ADCOM/EXCOM Committee Chairs or members
- Webmaster, social media coordinator, etc.

Eligibility is to be member of IEEE ENCS.

Nominations with a description of the achievement shall be sent to mhorrer@ieee. Deadline for nominations is October 31, 2019. The awards committee will decide on the merit of the nomination.

The award will be presented during our Awards Banquet in December.
