JAMES H. GRAHAM CYBERSECURITY SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

Deadline Extended to: 22 December 2024

Purpose:

To honor the legacy of the scholarship's namesake – James H. Graham and provide long-term support to encourage graduate study in the area of cybersecurity by well-qualified graduate students, who are members of the IEEE, at universities and colleges in IEEE Region 3. Mentors for these graduate students should be faculty members and hold current membership in a Region 3 IEEE Section.

Eligibility:

IEEE Student Members or Graduate Student Members in good standing.

Must have (or will be in their final term when the award is announced at SoutheastCon) a Bachelor's Degree in Electrical Engineering, Computer Engineering, Cybersecurity, or Computer Science.

Demonstrated interest in cybersecurity.

Minimum GPA of 3.0 on a 4-point scale.

Scholarship:

The \$1500 scholarship will be paid directly to the Institution to offset the awardee's costs.
